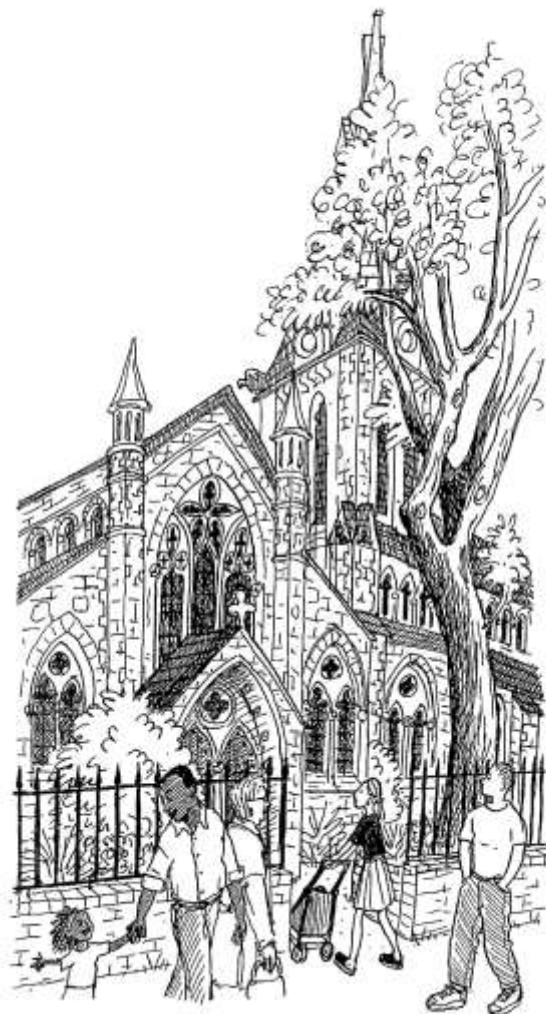
**Prayer Ministry** – Members of the team will be available in the Prayer Corner after the 11am service to pray with anyone who would value this.
