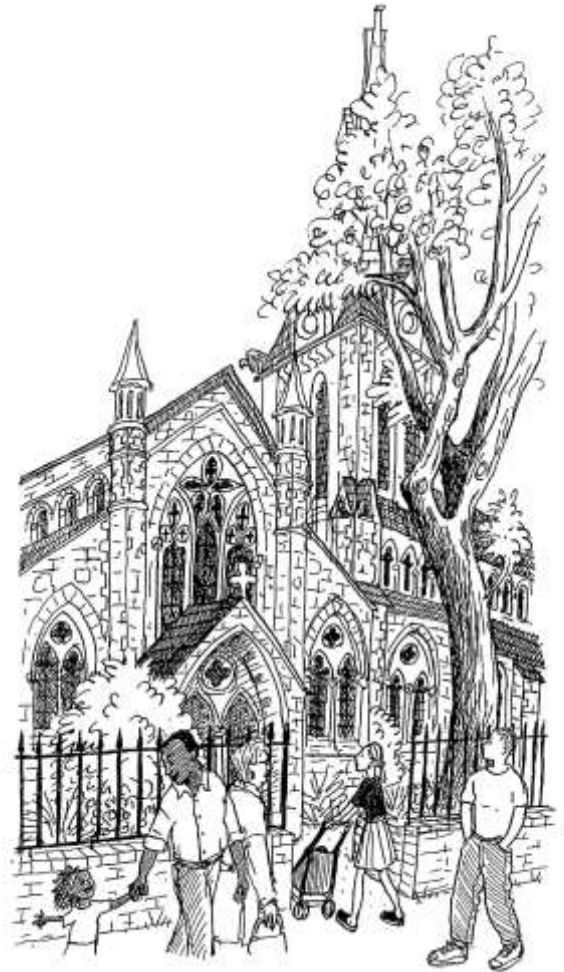
Prayer Ministry: Members of the team will be in the Prayer Corner after the 11am service to pray with anyone who would value this.

ISLINGTON CENTRE FOR REFUGEES AND MIGRANTS – Is celebrating its twentieth anniversary this year. Fundraising has been successful and since the beginning of March the Centre has been able to open for 3 days a week in term time. Since September the Centre has enjoyed the benefit of free space to rehearse at Christ Church. In addition to the teaching of English, advice, support and practical help is given to students. The Centre welcomes the generous donations by the congregation. Tea, coffee, lunch are provided and food supplies are distributed. Non-perishable food such as instant coffee, tea bags, milk (UHT), sugar, rice, pasta, sauces, tinned meat and vegetables, cereals, tins of tuna, tomatoes, beans, cooking oil and toiletries can be brought in to Christ Church on Sundays (clearly marked for the Centre) and either left on the table to the right of the kitchen hatch, or handed to me. VOLUNTARY TREASURER VACANCY: Do you have the time to become Christ Church Playgroup's Treasurer? We are a small committee who desperately need the support of a local person with accounting knowledge. The job includes BACs transfers (salaries, HMRC, suppliers) as well as financial reporting. We use a payroll company for working out salaries. Christ Church Playgroup is a nurturing pre-school run by qualified Early Years staff. It is managed by a voluntary committee which has the key job of overseeing the running of the Playgroup and setting its future direction. SYRIAN REFUGEE UPDATE: We continue to get to know most the eight refugee families now living in Islington. Indeed, several households are enjoying furniture you have donated. The family of Ameer Mohammed has just had a baby girl, Malek, so if you have any extra baby clothes, please drop them off at the vicarage office, and the Men in a Shed will deliver them. Also, Christ Church and Islington Citizens UK have found two places to live for additional Syrian families to be located in the borough, but we're still looking for accommodation for three more families. If we can find five homes for Syrian refugee families in Islington, the borough council has committed to finding five more.
