We are reliant on the generosity of you, our congregation. The success of our work depends on planned financial contributions from you. About 70% of our income needs to come from you.

As you know, our plans focus on the key areas of discipleship, children's ministry and outreach. However, to plan effectively we need an increase in regular giving. We require additional funds to maintain the posts of Church Administrator, Children's and Youth Worker, Music Director and Organist, to contribute to the Common Fund and support our mission partners and to carry out essential maintenance and repair. We are also looking forward to the exciting opportunities that will be available through building our new church office and community centre.

Regular giving - Planned regular giving enables you to spread your commitment across the year and is invaluable for our budgeting. Eg:

- £40 per month helps fund our Junior Church activities
- £93 was the average donation per household (through the Parish Giving Scheme and Standing Order) in March this year
- £100 per month helps with heating and lighting the Church
